Mental Health & Addictions

- Hold government accountable for its failure to adequately address PEI's mental health crisis.
- Continue to seek a commitment from government to restore and expand mental health and addictions services, including expediting construction of the new Mental Health hospital.

Fair & Affordable Housing

- Demand government recognize housing as a basic right and take decisive action to end the provincial housing crisis.
- Seek a commitment from government to reform the Residential Tenancy Act, including a fair and transparent consultation process and a rental registry.

Green Economic Recovery

- Encourage government to develop a vision and economic plan to safely navigate our post-COVID recovery.
- Hold government responsible for building an Island that creates greater security and prosperity for Islanders from tip to tip, including ensuring access to critical services in all communities.

Agriculture & Land

- Seek a commitment from government to establish better supports for farmers to transition towards more sustainable agriculture.
- Demand government reform the Planning Act and the Lands Protection Act without delay and ensure their spirit and intent is enforced.

Social Equity & Access to Justice

- Continue to pressure government to consider the needs of all Islanders when developing plans that impact their security and dignity.
- Ensure government does not overlook the needs of seniors, the BIPOC community, LGBTQ2S+ community, women, children and youth, and other marginalized groups.

Holding Government Accountable

- Continue to improve government policy in the areas of government spending, transparency and collaboration, and providing appropriate and necessary programs and services for Islanders regardless of where they find themselves on the socio-economic spectrum.
- Demand government explain to Islanders why it is prioritizing paving roads over Islanders' needs.
